



### **The Nativity**

*To you is born a Savior*

The infant Jesus is in the center. Joseph and Mary look on in adoration. In the stable background there is a cow.

#### **SYMBOLS**

The manger depicts the lowly birth. The drapery represents swaddling clothes.

The halo inscribed with IHS symbolizes Jesus. The messianic roses are at the sides.



### **The Visit of the Magi**

*We have come to worship Him*

The three wise men as kings are presenting their gifts to the child Jesus. Mary is seated behind the cradle. Light from the guiding star is streaming through the window.

#### **SYMBOLS**

The crown and rays with IHS represent Jesus, born king of the Jews. The star is the guiding star of the Magi.

The three small crowns represent the three kings. The treasure chest at the lower right symbolizes the gifts presented. Dromedaries, or eastern camels, are at the sides.
