

The Last Supper

This is for you

Jesus stands at the far end of the table holding the chalice in his left hand, while raising his right hand in blessing.

Five disciples are shown on one side of the table and six on the other. The betrayer Judas has left the scene.

SYMBOLS

The wheat represents the bread, the emblem of the broken body of Christ.

The grapes represent the wine, emblem of Christ's blood shed.

The cup and the wafer at the side symbolize the Last Supper.



The Crucifixion

My God, why?

Jesus hangs on the cross. St. Mary and St. John kneel at the foot of the cross. Two soldiers with spears stand behind.

SYMBOLS

The red cross represents the crucifixion. The winding sheet depicts the burial.

The darkened sun and moon are above. The nails symbolize the passion.

The globe partially visible below is a reminder that Christ died for the sins of the world.
