Adam and Eve, symbolizing humanity, are shown as silhouettes standing in a state of perfection.

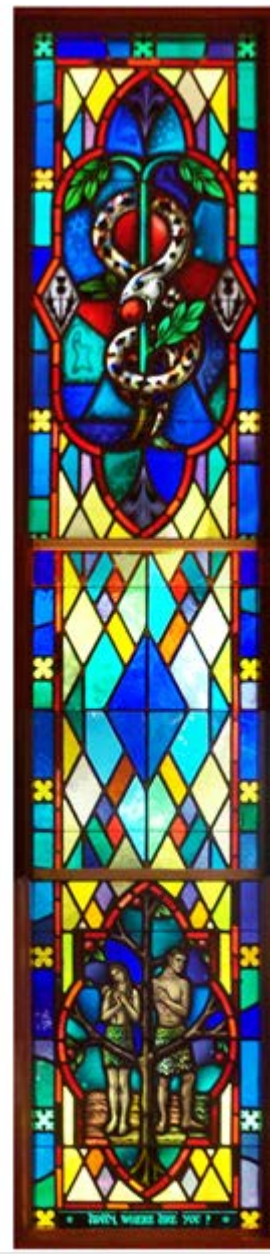
#### SYMBOLS
