The red cloud at the top represents the presence of God.

SYMBOLS

The kingship of David is symbolized by the crown.

The rod and the staff are reminders of his former life.

The harp speaks of his musical ability.

The star tells of prophecy—the Star of David.

The lions are the emblem of the Tribe of Judah.
